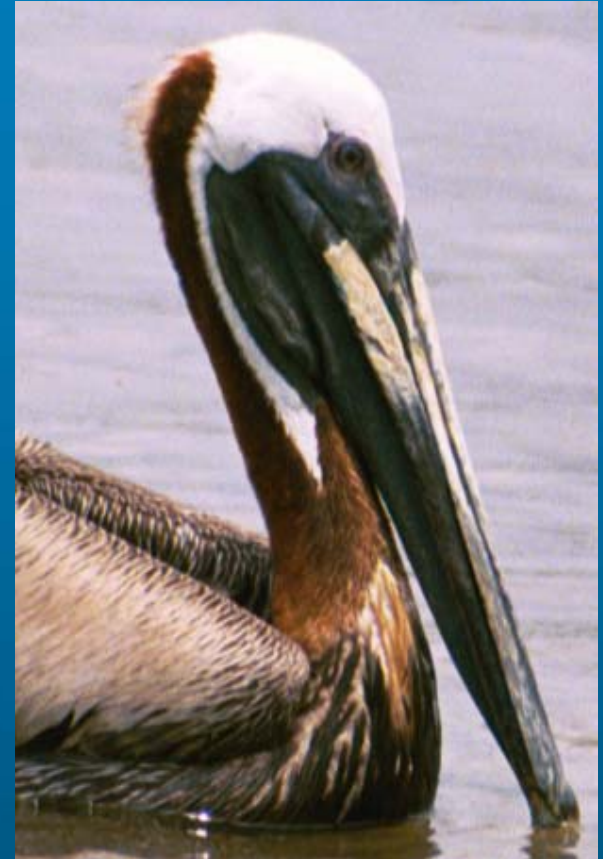

- 1 four-state regional agent



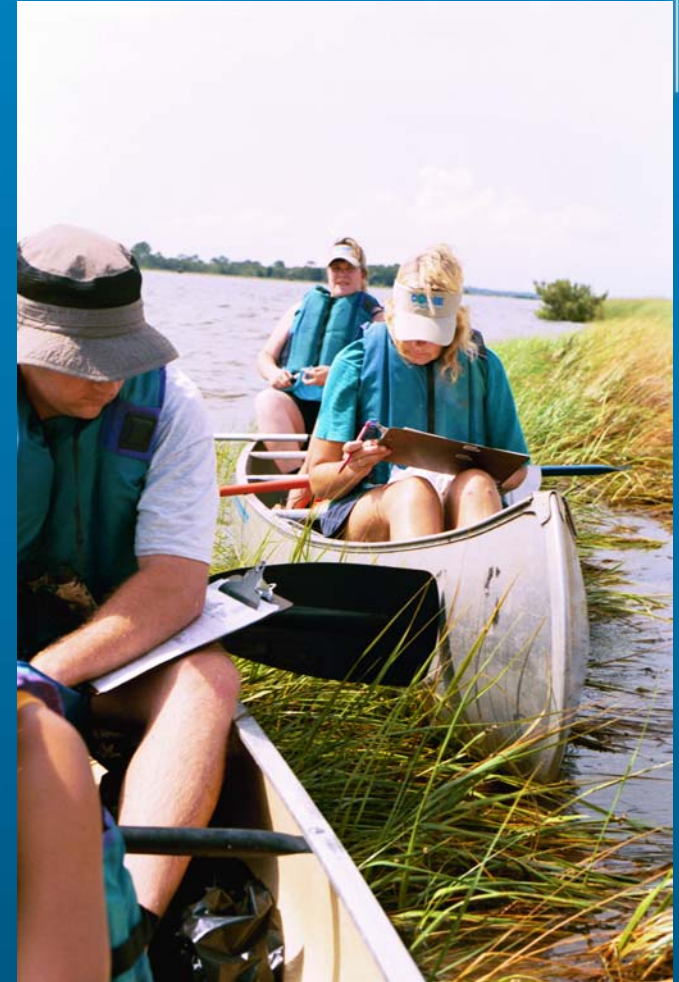
# State Specialists

# County Faculty

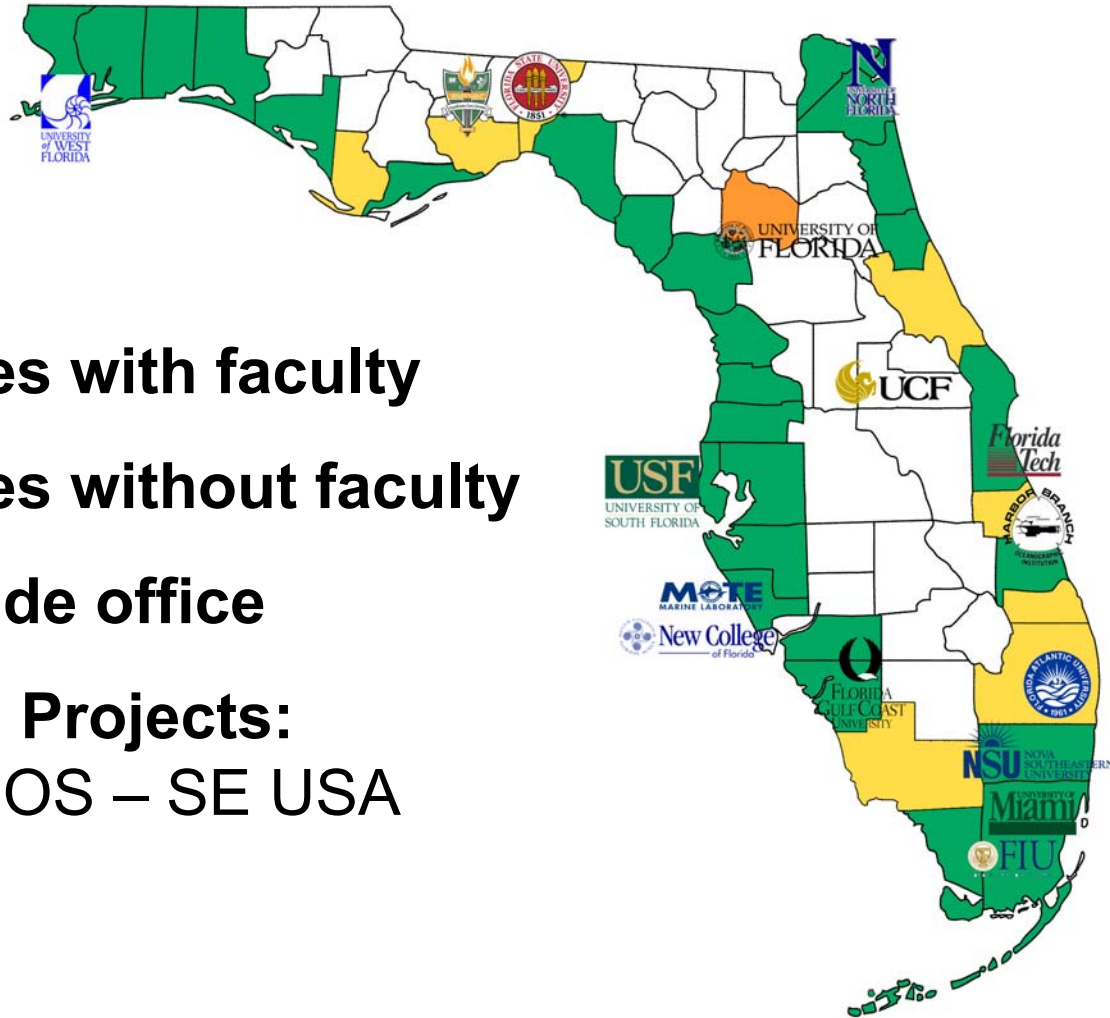
- **17 Field agents**
