2.	Required: Last day to submit Request for Defense Form and conduct a Sufficiency Meeting. Must provide the form and Outside Chairperson information to Academic Affairs Office.	March 17, 2017 (9 <sup>th</sup> Week)
3.	Required: Last day to defend dissertation and submit Successful Defense Form.	March 31, 2017 (11 <sup>th</sup> Week)
4.	Required: Deadline to submit Final Approved Dissertation to ProQuest, Certificate of Approval Form, 1 <sup>st</sup> Page of Plagiarism Check Summary, and NORC Survey to the Academic Affairs Office.	April 7, 2017 (12 <sup>th</sup> Week)

2.	Required: Last day to submit Request for Defense Form to Academic Affairs Office and conduct a Sufficiency Meeting.	March 3, 2017 (7 <sup>th</sup> Week)
3.	Required: Last day to defend thesis and submit Successful Defense Form.	March 17, 2017 (9 <sup>th</sup> Week)
4.	Required: Deadline to submit Final Approved Thesis to ProQuest, Certificate of Approval Form, and 1 <sup>st</sup> Page of Plagiarism Check Summary to the Academic Affairs Office.	March 24, 2017 (10 <sup>th</sup> Week)
